And lastly I give and bequeath all the residue and remainder of my Monies securities for Money farming stock and implements of husbandry household goods furniture and other personal Estate and effects whatsoever and wheresoever unto and equally between my son John Richardson Fog and my Daughter Margaret Fog absolutely share and share alike And I do hereby nominate and appoint my said son John Richardson Fog and my Daughter Margaret Fog Executor and Executrix of this my Will. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty six
